### **DIRECTIONS TO CANDIDATES**

All interns accepted into these Programmes will be paid a stipend and will be required to sign an Agreement with the Department. The duration of the contract is 12 months. An extensive internship programme is in place in the department to support the development of unemployed graduates by means of structured learning plans, mentorship, and ongoing interaction with other staff members and interns.
